For Your Information

The Oklahoma Dental Foundation offers courses throughout the year for all four of the expanded duty permits that may be obtained by **Dental Assistants** in the State of Oklahoma:

- Radiation Safety
- Coronal Polishing
- Sealant Application
- Nitrous Oxide (assisting only)

In addition, the ODF offers courses for the two advanced procedures that may be performed by licensed **Dental Hygienists** in the State of Oklahoma.:

- Nitrous Oxide
- Local Anesthesia

The ODF also offers three online training courses for anyone in the dental office.

- "Infection Control in the Dental Office" is a comprehensive course designed for new dental staff or anyone who has not had infection control training in a while.
- "Infection Control Refresher" is an abbreviated version for those who are required to have annual training or those looking to stay up-to-date on CDC and OSHA infection control recommendations.
- "HIPAA" which provides basic information to dental healthcare workers for compliance with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)

Things to Know Before Enrolling:

- Read the COURSE REQUIREMENTS page for each course before enrolling. This page includes very important information about its corresponding course.
- **SPACE IS LIMITED**. We can only accommodate the number of students as we have chairs/operatories. Courses often fill up before the Late enrollment begins.
- FOR DENTAL ASSISTANTS: The Oklahoma Board of Dentistry has removed the 1-year chairside
 requirement. However, we highly recommend no one enroll in this course until they are proficient in
 working in a mouth to ensure success in completing this course. Failing the clinical portion course will
 require repeating the entire course at full price.
- ALL applications must be submitted online. Payment can be made online with a credit/debit card -oryou can mail in your payment using a check or money order. If you choose to mail in your payment,
 your spot will not be reserved until payment is reserved and you may have to move to a later course
 date.

Things to Know After Enrolling:

- Course packets are emailed out at least two weeks before the course to the email address on the
 application. If you do not have your packet two weeks before the course 1) check your junk mail, then
 2) contact the ODF so we can resend it.
- Some courses require a patient for the exam or extracted teeth. Information to help you start securing a
 patient/finding teeth can be found on the COURSE REQUIREMENTS page for that course. Detailed
 information will be sent with your course packet.
- Read over your course packet carefully as soon as you receive it. Waiting until the last minute can be detrimental to your success.
